- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to permit the possession of firearms by certain employees.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 22-14 be amended by adding a NEW SECTION to read:
- 4 An employer, whether public or private, may not prohibit an employee from keeping a
- 5 legally owned and lawfully possessed firearm locked inside a private motor vehicle in a parking
- 6 lot under the employer's control.
- 7 The prohibition in this section does not apply to:
- 8 (1) Any property under federal jurisdiction;
- 9 (2) Any school district;
- 10 (3) Any correctional facility;
- 11 (4) Any entity providing shelter or programs to victims of domestic violence or sexual
- 12 assault;
- 13 (5) The South Dakota Human Services Center;
- 14 (6) The South Dakota Developmental Center; or

1 (7) Any employer that is required to restrict firearms in accordance with the terms of a
