## **HOUSE BILL 683**

## By VanHuss

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to information on firearm ownership by students, families, teachers, and school employees.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 2, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated section:

- (a) No school administrator, teacher, or other employee of an LEA shall require a student or the student's parent to provide information on firearm ownership by the student's family.
- (b) No school administrator or other employee of an LEA shall require a teacher or other school employee to provide information on firearm ownership by the teacher or school employee.
- (c) Any information on firearm ownership that is voluntarily provided by a student, parent, teacher, or LEA employee shall not be the basis for adverse disciplinary action against a student or adverse employment action against a teacher or LEA employee; provided, however, that this subsection shall not prohibit adverse disciplinary or employment action based on a violation of title 39, chapter 17, part 13.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
