## **HOUSE BILL 1910**

## By Bulso

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 38 and Title 39, relative to the sale of firearms.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) The Tennessee bureau of investigation shall study the feasibility of the development and implementation of a software application capable of being utilized on a voluntary basis by gun owners in this state who are not engaged in the business of importing, manufacturing, or dealing in firearms pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 921 and 923, for the purpose of conducting a criminal history record check on a proposed purchaser of a used or second-hand firearm through a private sale.
- (b) By January 1, 2025, the Tennessee bureau of investigation shall report its findings to the speaker of the house of representatives, the speaker of the senate, the chair of the civil justice committee of the house of representatives, and the chair of the judiciary committee of the senate. The report must include an analysis of the cost to develop the application and to provide this service to residents of this state.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
