A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Government from requiring race or ethnicity to be disclosed in connection with the transfer of a firearm.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Firearm Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT RE-**
2 **QUIRING RACE OR ETHNICITY TO BE DIS-**
3 **CLOSED IN CONNECTION WITH THE TRANS-**
4 **FER OF A FIREARM.**

5 The Federal Government may not require any person
6 to disclose the race or ethnicity of the person in connection
7 with the transfer of a firearm to the person.
