To provide that any United States Government identification document issued for an illegal alien is not sufficient to meet the identification document requirement for acquiring a firearm from a Federal firearms licensee, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Guns for Illegal
5 Aliens Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INSUFFICIENCY OF IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS**
2 **ISSUED FOR AN ILLEGAL ALIEN IN MEETING**
3 **THE IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENT REQUIRE-**
4 **MENT FOR ACQUIRING A FIREARM FROM A**
5 **FEDERAL FIREARMS LICENSEE.**

6 Section 922(t)(1)(D) of title 18, United States Code,
7 is amended by inserting “, other than an identification
8 document issued for an alien (as defined in section 101(a)
9 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
10 1101(a))) who has not been admitted (as so defined),” be-
11 fore “of the transferee containing”.
