A BILL

To reduce, from 21 years of age to 18 years of age, the minimum age at which a person may obtain a handgun from a Federal firearms licensee.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Second Amendment
5 For Every Registrable Voter Act” or the “SAFER Voter
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM AGE FOR OBTAINING A HANDGUN FROM**
2 **A FEDERAL FIREARMS LICENSEE.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 922(b)(1) of title 18,
4 United States Code, is amended by striking “, and, if the
5 firearm, or ammunition is other than a shotgun or rifle,
6 or ammunition for a shotgun or rifle, to any individual
7 who the licensee knows or has reasonable cause to believe
8 is less than twenty-one years of age”.

9 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section 922(e)(1)
10 of such title is amended by striking “, in the case of any
11 firearm other than a shotgun or a rifle, I am twenty-one
12 years or more of age, or that, in the case of a shotgun
13 or a rifle,”.
