- 13 (a) A person shall not possess a firearm if the person has been convicted of

- 15 (b) A person who violates this section shall be imprisoned not more than
- 16 two years or fined not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
- 17 (c) This section shall not apply to a person who is exempt from federal
- 18 <u>firearms restrictions under 18 U.S.C. § 925(c).</u>

(d) As used in this section:
(1) "Firearm" means any weapon, whether loaded or unloaded, which
will expel a projectile by the action of an explosive and includes any weapon
commonly referred to as a pistol, revolver, rifle, gun, machine gun, or shotgun.
(2) "Violent felony" means a listed crime as defined in subdivision
5301(7) of this title or an offense involving sexual exploitation of children in
violation of chapter 64 of this title.
