1 AN ACT Relating to making licensed dealer delivery provisions
2 consistent with federal law; and amending RCW 9.41.092.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9.41.092 and 2015 c 1 s 4 (Initiative Measure No.
5 594) are each amended to read as follows:

6 Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a licensed dealer
7 may not deliver any firearm to a purchaser or transferee until the
8 earlier of:

9 (1) The results of all required background checks are known and
10 the purchaser or transferee is not prohibited from owning or
11 possessing a firearm under federal or state law; or

12 (2) (~~Ten~~) Three business days have elapsed from the date the
13 licensed dealer requested the background check. However, for sales
14 and transfers of pistols if the purchaser or transferee does not have
15 a valid permanent Washington driver's license or state identification
16 card or has not been a resident of the state for the previous
17 consecutive ninety days, then the time period in this subsection
18 shall be extended from ten business days to sixty days.
