## SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 829

February 8, 2024 – Offered by Senator WANGGAARD. \*\*\*AUTHORS SUBJECT TO CHANGE\*\*\*

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

**1.** Page 2, line 11: delete lines 11 to 14 and substitute:

3 "165.85 (2) (fh) "Tactical emergency medical services professional" means a 4 licensed emergency medical services professional who has been endorsed by the 5 department of health services as a person who provides medical services when 6 operating as part of a law enforcement tactical team and operating with the prior 7 written approval of the sheriff or chief of police for the jurisdiction in which the 8 licensed emergency medical services professional is authorized to carry out his or her 9 duties.".

10 2. Page 4, line 17: after "professional." insert "No person may be certified as 11 a tactical emergency medical services professional without the prior written 12 approval of the sheriff or chief of police for the jurisdiction in which the tactical 13 emergency medical services professional is authorized to carry out his or her duties. 2023 - 2024 Legislature

The sheriff or chief of police must have authority and responsibility over the team
 on which he or she is approving the tactical emergency medical services professional
 to go armed with a firearm.".

- **3.** Page 5, line 9: delete lines 9 to 15 and substitute:
  "5. a. No person may continue to be certified as a tactical emergency medical
  services professional unless that person maintains employment as a tactical
  emergency medical services professional, maintains the approval of the sheriff or
  chief of police for the jurisdiction in which the tactical emergency medical services
  professional is authorized to carry out his or her duties, and meets annual
  recertification training standards.".
- 4. Page 5, line 23: delete "professional" and substitute "professional, as
  defined in s. 165.85 (2) (fh),".
